Nurture Term 5: Language Is A Vital Means Of Communication - The Words We Use When We Talk To Eachother Is Important

Zones of regulation are established, and pupils and staff engage with it. Any child that highlights that they are not in a positive frame of mind, are identified by adults and are subtly approached to help them settle into the school day.

The zones of regulation are placed in all classrooms and we have shared them on Dojo so you can use them at home too.

Barming Primary School staff begin teaching our pupils this through model behaviour, using appropriate social language that is always clear and consistent. Not only with one another but with the children, parents and the wider school community. This goes beyond the spoken word to body language, facial expressions and tone of voice.
