Nurture - Term 4: All Behaviour Is Communication – Our Behaviour Is Telling You Something

Our pupils are given clear instructions of expectations, boundaries and consequences which are consistent with every member of staff. Consistency is key to making our pupils feel safe, to know what to expect, as routine offers children repetition and repetition offers children predictability and learning. Predictability makes children feel safe.

A big part of this is through building positive relationships with the children, which our staff thrive in. Making the most of our wellbeing times every day, break times are imperative for this. We engage with the children through play, to make them feel valued, to build a connection so that if a challenging time occurs we are better prepared due to having knowledge of the individual child and their needs.
